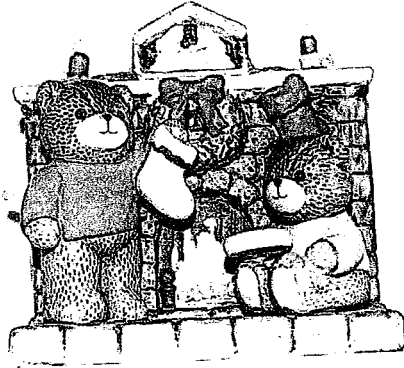

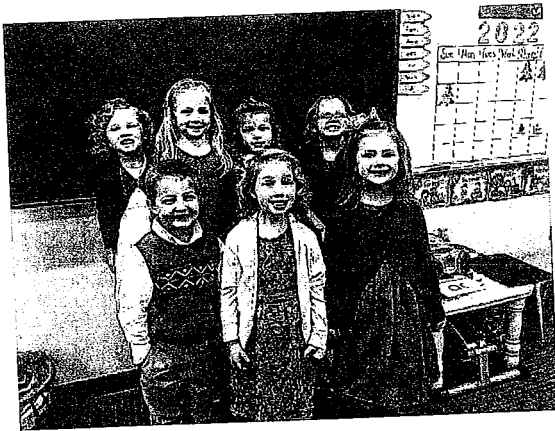
# Mrs. Moore's Preschool

Kindergarten will also be starting their spelling class when they get back from break!!

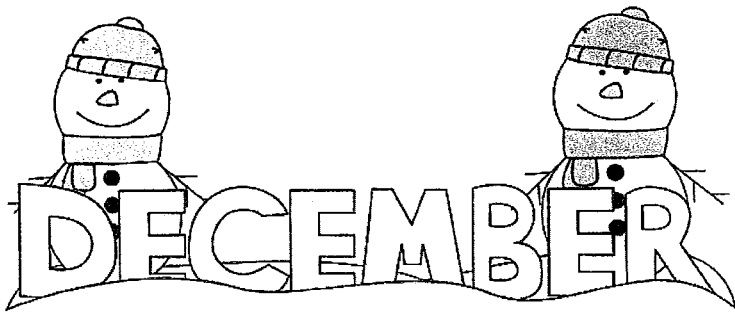
### Christmas Concert

### This Month's Activities

We have already made it through half the school year! I can't believe how fast it has gone. Reminder, with the colder weather, please make sure your child brings their hats and gloves to school.

In Phonics, we have been working on recognizing beginning blends. Some of the "r-blends", such as /dr/ and /tr/ can be a little tricky.

In Math, we just finished our unit on adding tens and comparing numbers. When we come back, we will begin a unit on making a ten to help us add and subtract.

As our Phonics skills increase, so does our Reading abilities. We continue to read our leveled readers and work on our reading comprehension skills. We have been studying some non-fiction texts and learning about features found in them, such as a Table of Contents and Glossary. Now, we are using those features to create our own informational stories about our favorite animals.

In Social Studies, we just finished a unit on where people live. We used directions to find places on maps, discussed the seven continents, talked about the differences between states and countries, and identified different resources.

In Science, we have been researching our favorite animals as we work to create our non-fiction stories.

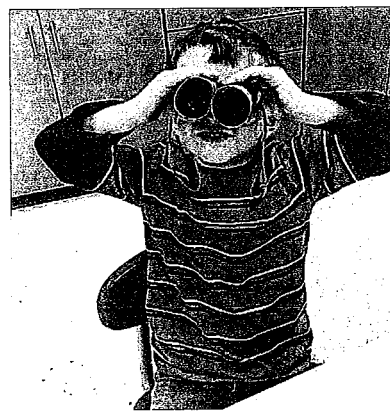
We celebrated Lewis' birthday on November 28<sup>th</sup>. Jackson will celebrate his when we come back to school on January 4<sup>th</sup>.

In math, the 3<sup>rd</sup> graders have been busy working on fractions: comparing to 1, finding equivalent, and understanding mixed numbers and improper fractions. That Smarter Balance test is sneaking up quickly, and fractions are a tested skill in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. 2<sup>nd</sup> graders are in the middle of a large unit working on subtracting with regrouping.

In English we are continuing our study on verbs. In Science we finished up a unit on fossils, and now we are just beginning a social studies chapter on our physical geography.

In reading we continue to discuss common core standards such as nonfiction text/graphic features and theme. We also took some time to read about how other countries around the world celebrate the Christmas season.

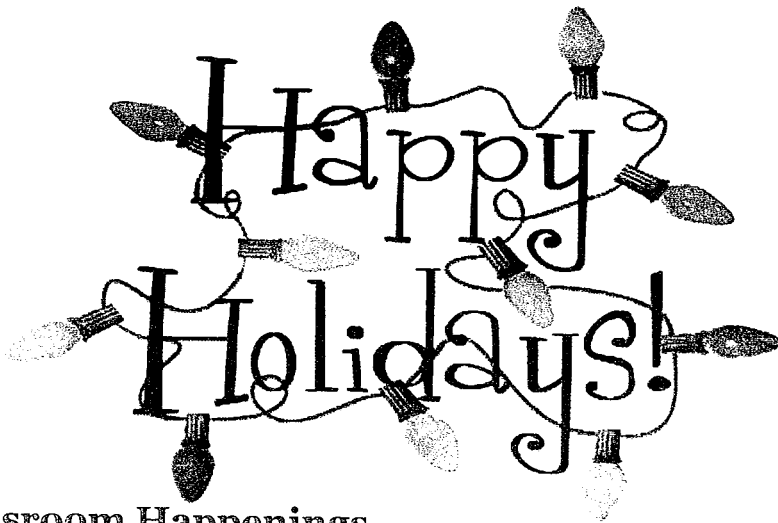

## White Lake After School Program / WiLdKat S.T.E.P.S

For the last two years, the enrollment fees for the White Lake After School Program (and recently the WiLdKat S.T.E.P.S program) have been covered by Covid-19 grant funding. That grant funding is set to expire at the end of December. We will be returning to the previous fees for the After School Program starting in January- those same fees will apply to the S.T.E.P.S program on Wednesdays as well.

Enrollment fees will be based on the Free/Reduced applications:

- \*For a standard family the fee is \$1.00/day with the price cut in half for each additional family member.

- \*The reduced fee is \$.50/day with the price cut in half for each additional family member.

- \*Free students are still free.
